

1. Short title. 2. Amendment of Section 7 (1) and Section 43 (1) and (2) of 4 Geo. V. No. 38.

AN ACT to amend "The Coroners Act, 1913." `[15 November, 1920.]

A.D. 1920.

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Coroners Amendment Act, Short title. 1920," and shall be construed as one with "The Coroners Act, 1913," 4 Geo. V. No. 38. which is herein referred to as "the said Act."

2 Subsection (1) of Section Seven and Subsections (1) and (2) of Amendment of Section Forty-three of the said Act are amended by adding, at the end Section 7 (1) and

of each of those Three subsections, the following proviso:—

"Provided that, either instead of or in addition to the mileage allow- No. 38. ance mentioned in Paragraph in of this subsection, there shall be paid such further or other sum (if any) as the Attorney-General may in any particular case approve as and for reasonable expenses incurred in or about the matters aforesaid."
