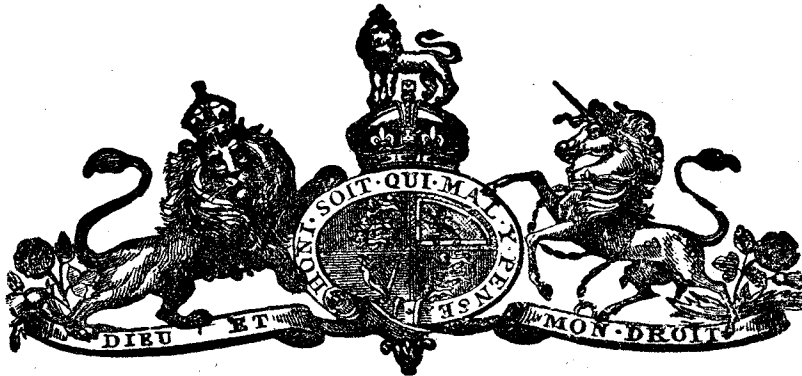

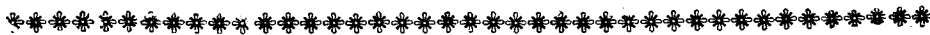

AN ACT to amend "The Coroners Act,
1913." [15 November, 1920.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Coroners Amendment Act, 1920," and shall be construed as one with "The Coroners Act, 1913," which is herein referred to as "the said Act."

2 Subsection (1) of Section Seven and Subsections (1) and (2) of Section Forty-three of the said Act are amended by adding, at the end of each of those Three subsections, the following proviso:—

"Provided that, either instead of or in addition to the mileage allowance mentioned in Paragraph II. of this subsection, there shall be paid such further or other sum (if any) as the Attorney-General may in any particular case approve as and for reasonable expenses incurred in or about the matters aforesaid."
