AN ACT to further amend "The Contagious A.D. 1900. Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1861." [6 *December*, 1900.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend the Law relating to the PREAMBLE. Quarantine of Cattle imported from New Zealand.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Short title. Act, 1900."
 - 2 "The Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1890," is hereby repealed. Repeal. 54 Vict. No. 4.
- 3 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Sixth Cattle from New Section of "The Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1880," all Cattle Zealand to be imported into this Colony from New Zealand other than for slaughter shall, on arrival, be landed as prescribed by the said Section of the said Act, and shall be detained at such Quarantine Ground as is mentioned 44 Vict. No. 12 Act, and shall be detained at such Quarantine Ground as is mentioned n the said Section for such period as the Chief Inspector appoints, not being less than Ninety days from the importation thereof.

4 This Act, and "The Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1861," and Acts to be read every Act amending the same, shall, save as amended by this Act, be together. read and construed together as one Act.
