AN ACT to amend *The Carriage Duties Act*.
[29 September, 1865.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend *The Carriage Duties Act*: PREAMBLE.
Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The Duties payable under *The Carriage Duties Act* shall be paid By whom Duties
by every person who keeps and uses any Carriage described in the to be paid.
Schedule thereto, whether as owner or otherwise.

2 The Form (2) in the Schedule to the said Act is hereby repealed, Form of Licence
and the Form in the Schedule hereto is substituted in lieu thereof. substituted for
Form (2) in
Schedule to

3 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the said Act, no greater sum than Six Pounds shall be payable as the proper Duties to be paid by any person in respect of the Carriages kept and used by him, otherwise than for the purpose of being let for hire, and in respect of which he shall be duly licensed under the said Act. Not more than

4 Upon the hearing of any complaint or information in respect of any breach of the said Act, it shall be sufficient for the Complainant or Informant to prove that the Defendant kept and used a Carriage described in the Schedule thereto, and thereupon the burden of proving that such keeping and user was duly authorised or licensed shall be upon the Defendant. Carriage Duties.

Appropriation of penalties.

5 One moiety of every penalty imposed under the said Act shall be paid to the Complainant or Informant, and the other moiety thereof shall be paid and applied in aid of the Municipal Fund of the Municipality within which the offence was committed, or otherwise to the Colonial Treasurer in aid of the General Revenue.

Acts to be read together.

6 This Act and *The Carriage Duties Act* shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.

Short Title.

7 In referring to this Act it shall be sufficient to use the expression *The Carriage Duties Act, No. 2.*

SCHEDULE.

LICENCE to keep Carriage.

WHEREAS *A.B.* has applied to me to grant to him a Licence to keep and use a Carriage [*or Carriages*], being a [*here insert kind of Carriage or Carriages, and the number of Wheels of each*]: And whereas I have this day also received the sums of money payable under *The Carriage Duties Act* in respect of such Carriage [*or Carriages*]; I do therefore hereby grant to the said *A.B.* license to keep and use the said Carriage [*or Carriages*] until the Fifteenth day of *October* now next ensuing.
