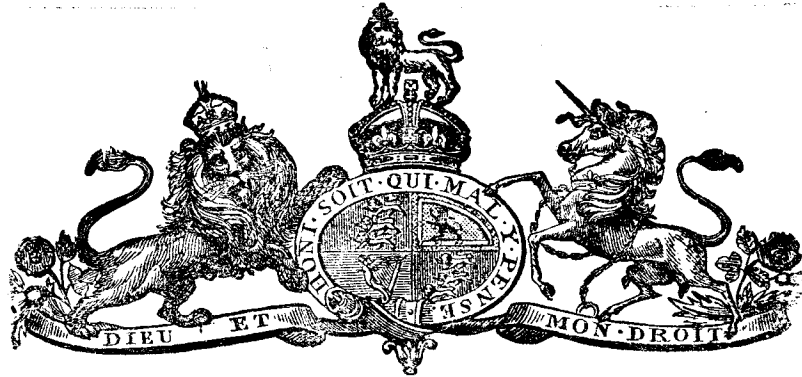

AN ACT to authorise a Loan of Four hundred A.D. 1918.
Pounds to the Council of the Municipality
of Campbell Town for the purpose of erect-
ing and equipping Public Abattoirs for
the Town of Campbell Town in accord-
ance with the provisions of "The Local
Public Works Loans Act, 1890," and for
other purposes. [23 December, 1918.]

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Campbell Town PREAMBLE.
has decided to erect, equip, and maintain public abattoirs for the Town
of Campbell Town :

And whereas the said Council is desirous of obtaining legislative
authority to borrow the money necessary to carry out the said works
under the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890":

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Campbell Town Municipality Short title.
Loan Act, 1918."

Campbell Town Municipality Loan.

A.D. 1918.

Interpretation.

2 In this Act—

“The Corporation” means the Warden, Councillors, and Electors of the Municipality of Campbell Town :

“The Council” means the Council of the said Municipality.

Power to borrow
£400.

3 It shall be lawful for the Council, on behalf of the corporation, to borrow under the provisions of “The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890,” and any amendments thereof, upon the security of all its revenues, any sum or sums of money not exceeding the sum of Four hundred Pounds, for the purpose of defraying the cost of erecting and equipping public abattoirs for the Town of Campbell Town.

Proviso that
Section 2 of “The
Local Public
Works Loans
Act, 1890,” not
to apply.

4 The proviso of Section Two of “The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890,” shall not apply to any loan authorised by this Act, but before any money is advanced under the provisions of this Act the Engineer-in-Chief shall certify that he is satisfied with the manner in which the Council has spent or proposes to spend the money, and that in his opinion the works have been or can be completed for the amount proposed to be expended thereon, and such certificate shall be submitted to and approved by the Governor.

5 Subject to the foregoing provisions it shall be lawful for the Governor to grant, in accordance with the provisions of “The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890,” and its amendments, any such sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Four hundred Pounds as a loan to the said Council upon the security of all its revenues for the purposes mentioned in Section Three of this Act, and such sum or sums of money shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose.

6 Interest at a rate to be fixed and determined by the Governor from time to time, pursuant to “The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890,” and its amendments, and computed from the date of payment to the Council of the first instalment on account of the said loan, shall be payable by the Council to the Treasurer upon the said loan until repayment thereof : Provided that “The Local Public Works Loans Amendment Act, 1904,” as amended by “The Local Public Works Loans Amendment Act, 1916,” shall be read and construed in its application to the loan authorised by this Act as if the maximum rate of interest thereby prescribed were omitted, and as if the words “Two Pounds” were substituted for the words “One Pound” mentioned in Paragraph 11. of Section Two.

Terms and
conditions.

7 The loan authorised by this Act shall be made on and subject to such other terms and conditions as the Governor may impose or approve in all respects.
