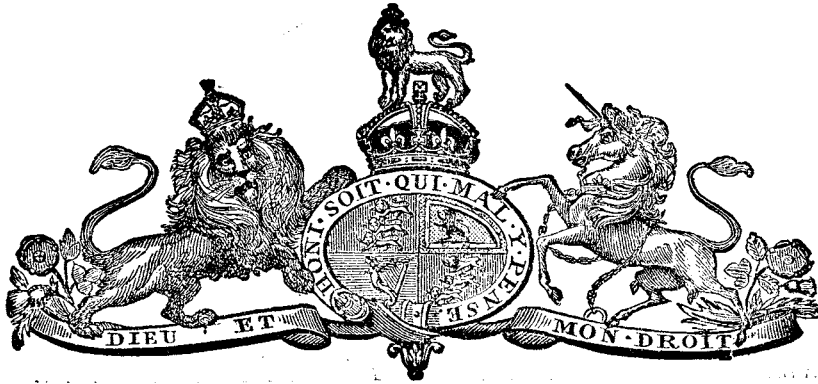

AN ACT to amend the Cressy Water Act, 1894. A.D. 1930.
[23 December, 1930.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as “The Cressy Water Act, 1930.” Short title.

(2) The Cressy Water Act, 1894, is in this Act referred to as “the Principal Act.” 58 Vict. No. 34.

2 It shall be lawful for the trustees to raise by way of loan, under the provisions of the Local Bodies Loans Act, in addition to any moneys formerly raised, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Eight hundred Pounds, for the purposes of the Principal Act.

3 The interest to be paid by the trustees in respect of the moneys borrowed in pursuance of this Act shall be at such rate, and the moneys shall be repaid within such period, as the Auditor-General shall determine.
