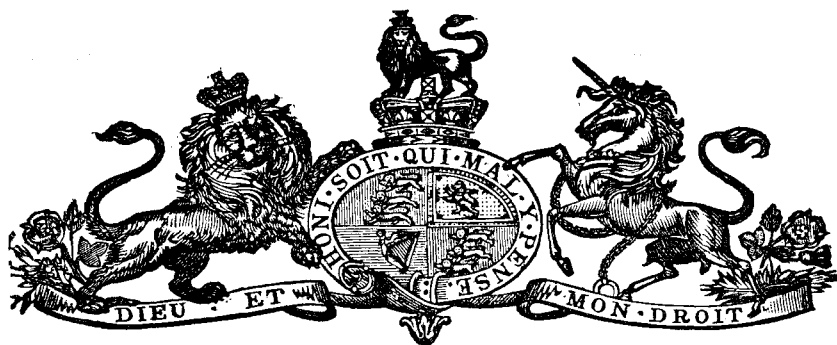

AN ACT to provide for the Appropriation of A.D. 1889.
certain Sums of Money for the Purposes
of the Defence of the Colony of *Tasmania*.
[4 February, 1889.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Defence Appropriation Act, 1888.” Short title.

2 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause the several works for the Defence of the Colony mentioned in the Schedule to be constructed and completed, at a cost for each separate work not exceeding the amount therein set opposite such work. Governor in Council to cause works to be constructed.

3 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause to be provided the several articles, materials, matters, and things necessary for the Defence of the Colony which are mentioned in the said Schedule, at a cost for the same respectively not exceeding that set forth in the said Schedule. Governor in Council to cause to be provided certain articles, &c.

4 The Governor in Council may, upon the recommendation of the Treasurer for the time being, out of the moneys hereby appropriated, authorise the Treasurer to purchase, acquire, and take any land, with or without buildings thereon, which he deems suitable for the purposes of any work by this Act authorised. Purchase of land, &c.
