

ANALYSIS.

 Short title. Incorporation.
Repeal of Section 13 of 7 Ed. VII. No. 36, and substitution of new section therefor.

AN ACT to amend "The District Justices 1910, Act, 1907." [20 December, 1910.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1 This Act may be cited as "The District Justices Amendment Short title. Act, 1910," and shall be construed as one with "The District Justices Incorporation. 7 Ed. VII. No. 36. Act, 1907."

District Justices Amendment.

Repeal of Section 13 of 7 Ed. VII. No. 36, and substitution of new section therefor. See 54 Vict. No. 1105, s. 17 (Vic.).

2 Section Thirteen of "The District Justices Act, 1907," is hereby repealed, and the following section is hereby substituted therefor:—

"13 No justice shall be disabled from acting in the due discharge and execution of his duties as justice in any matter relating to any city, town, or municipality by reason only of his being a ratepayer, or a member of, or interested in, the concerns of the corporation of any such city or municipality."
