

## AN ACT to amend "The Drainage Promotion 1924, Act, 1917." [8 December, 1924.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as "The Drainage Promotion Act, Short title.
- (2) "The Drainage Promotion Act, 1917," is herein called "the Principal Act. Principal Act." 8 Geo. V. No. 55.
- 2 Subsection (2) of Section Nine of the Principal Act is hereby Amendment of amended by deleting the words "Three times" in the first line of the Subsection (2) of said subsection, and substituting the word "Twice" therefor said subsection, and substituting the word "Twice" therefor.

### Drainage Promotion.

Amendment of Section 22 of the Principal Act. Amendment of Section 27 of the Principal Act.

- 3 Section Twenty-two of the Principal Act is hereby amended by deleting the word "Five" in the third line thereof, and substituting the word "Ten" therefor.
- 4 Section Twenty-seven of the Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after the word "borrow" in the last line thereof, the following words:—"Provided further that, in the case of a drainage area of which not less than one-third is Crown land, the trustees shall not proceed to borrow any sum of money under the authority of this Act, unless the Minister shall have previously approved in writing of such borrowing."

Amendment of Section 29 of the Principal Act. 5 Section Twenty-nine of the Principal Act is hereby amended by deleting the words "Three times" in the second line thereof, and substituting the word "Twice" therefor.
