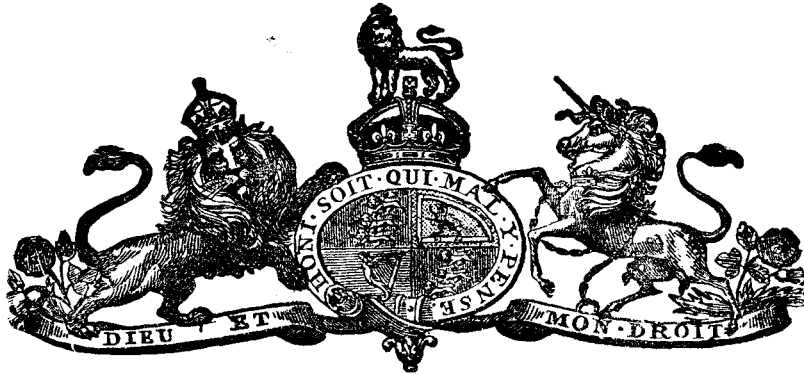

AN ACT to authorise the granting of a Mining Lease at a Peppercorn Rental to *Douglas Percy Douglas* subject to the provisions of the Mining Act, 1917.

WHEREAS *Douglas Percy Douglas* was the holder of a lease, PREAMBLE. dated the twenty-second day of July, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen, under the provisions of the Mining Act, 1905, in respect of two hundred and forty acres of land, situate in the vicinity of Ida Bay, in the County of Kent in Tasmania, and numbered 5016-m for the term of eighteen years at the yearly rent of one peppercorn :

And whereas the said *Douglas Percy Douglas* entered into an agreement with the General Manager of the State Hydro-Electric Department to surrender his said lease with the object of releasing portion, namely twenty acres, of the area comprised therein for the purposes of the Carbide and Electro Products Limited then under

the supervision or control of the said General Manager on behalf of the State, upon the understanding that the said Department would procure for the said *Douglas Percy Douglas* a new lease in respect of the balance of such area, namely two hundred and twenty acres :

And whereas the said lease was surrendered as from the first day of October one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, but through inadvertence application for a new lease in respect of the said two hundred and twenty acres was not made within the time prescribed under the Mining Act, 1917 :

And whereas it is desirable that such lease should be granted to the said *Douglas Percy Douglas* :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as “The *Douglas Percy Douglas* Mining Lease Enabling Act, 1926.”

Power to Minister to grant lease.

2—(1) It shall be lawful for the Minister, with the consent of the Governor, to grant to the said *Douglas Percy Douglas* a stone lease under and in accordance with the provisions of the Mining Act, 1917, in respect of the aforesaid area of two hundred and twenty acres, being the land comprised in the section designated in the books of the Mines Department and known as 9339-M.

(2) The term of such lease shall be six years and four months from the twenty-second day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six.

(3) The yearly rental in respect of such lease shall be one peppercorn.
