

AN ACT to further amend "The Electoral Act, 1920. 1907," and for other purposes. [20 November, 1920.]

WHEREAS by the death of the Honorable Ellis Dean, a vacancy PREAMBLE. has occurred in the Council for the Council District of Derwent, and a . writ bearing date the 18th day of November, 1920, was signed by the Governor and issued in accordance with Section Fifty-nine of "The Electoral Act, 1907":

And whereas by the operation of Section Thirty-eight of the said Act the time for the enrolment of the names of persons entitled to have their names enrolled for the said District by virtue of "The Constitution (War Service Franchise) Act, 1920," has been insufficient, and it is

therefore desirable to cancel the said writ and issue a fresh writ in lieu thereof, and to extend the time for the issue of writs in cases where vacancies occur in the Council at any time not within Four months immediately preceding the day for holding the periodical election of Members of the Council:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as "The Electoral Act, 1920," and shall 7 Ed. VII. No. 6. be construed as one with "The Electoral Act, 1907" (herein referred to as " the said Act").

Amendment of Section 59 of 7 Ed. VII. No. 6.

2 Section Fifty-nine of the said Act is hereby amended by substituting the word "Forty" for the word "Ten" in the last line thereof.

Retrospective effect.

3 The said Act shall be read and construed as if the amendment contained in Section Two hereof had been made on the First day of November, One thousand nine hundred and twenty.

Cancellation of writ for Council District of Derwent.

4 The said writ referred to in the Preamble to this Act together with everything done thereunder or by virtue thereof is hereby declared to be null and void, and of no effect whatsoever, and a new writ shall be issued to fill the said vacancy under the terms of the said Act as amended by this Act.
