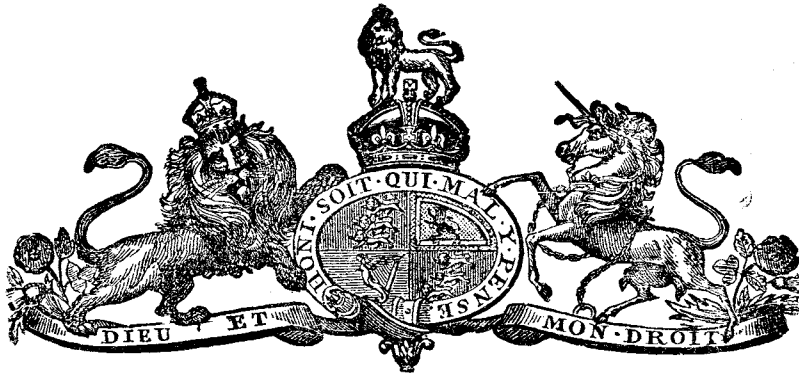

AN ACT to amend "The Education Act, 1885." [31 March, 1924.]

A.D. 1924.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Education Act, 1924."

Short title

2 Section Twenty-two of "The Education Act, 1885," inserted therein by "The Education Act, 1912," is hereby amended—

- i. By inserting after the figures "22" in the first line thereof, the figure "(1)": and
- ii. By inserting after the end of the said section the following new Subsection (2)—

"(2) Such authorisation as aforesaid may be given in writing either on a separate document or endorsed on the complaint made against such parent, and signed by the Minister or by the Chairman or Secretary of the Board of Advice for the district, and if so given shall be sufficient."
