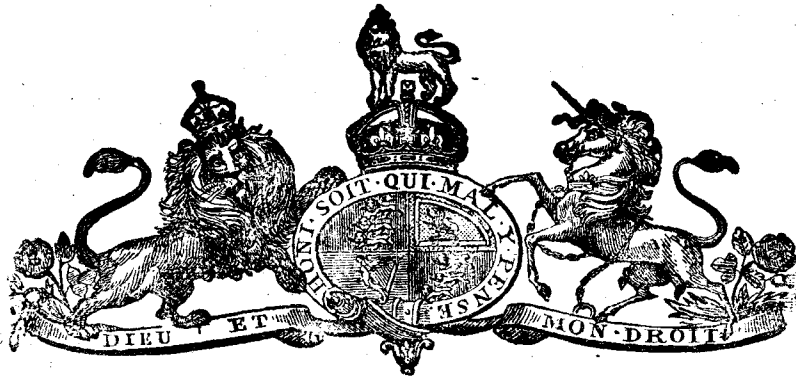

AN ACT to further amend "The Education Act, 1885," and for other purposes. A.D. 1919.  
[24 December, 1919.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as "The Education Amendment Act, 1919," and shall be read and construed as one with "The Education Act, 1885," and every amendment thereof.

**2** Subsection (1) of Section Twenty-one of "The Education Act, 1885," is hereby amended by repealing Paragraph vi. thereof, and substituting therefor the following :—

Amendment of Section 21 of 49 Vict. No. 15, by repealing Paragraph vi. and substituting a new paragraph.

"vi. That the child, with the consent of the Minister, has been exempted by the Board of Advice for the district from attendance at school, and that the period of such exemption has not expired."

**3** Section Twenty-four of "The Education Act, 1885," is hereby amended by repealing Paragraph xi. thereof, and substituting therefor the following:—

"xi. To grant, subject to the approval of the Minister, exemption from attendance at school to any child for any period not exceeding Four consecutive weeks, and from time to time to grant to any school a holiday for the whole day, or for half a day, in accordance with the Regulations."
