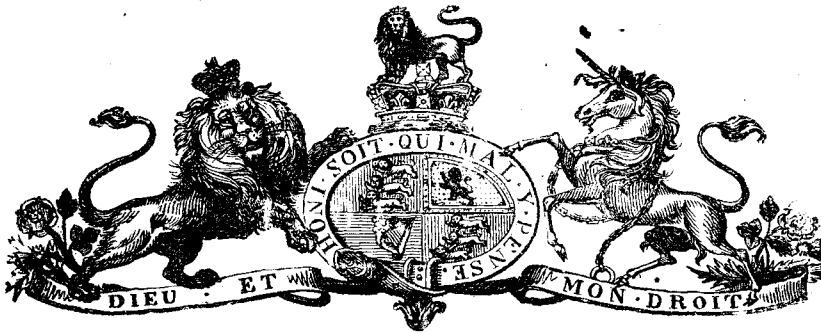

AN ACT to continue "The Electoral Act, A.D. 1901.
1896," and for other purposes.

[30 December, 1901.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Electoral Act Continuation Act, 1901."

2 "The Electoral Act, 1896," as amended by "The Electoral Act Continuation and Amendment Act, 1899," and "The Electoral Act Continuation and Amendment Act, 1900," shall remain and continue in full force and operation until the Thirtieth day of *September*, One

thousand nine hundred and two, or until the present House of Assembly of *Tasmania* is dissolved, whichever shall first happen.

Certain vacancies
in Legislative
Council not to
be filled up.

3 Notwithstanding anything contained in any Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania*, it shall not be necessary for the Governor to issue a Writ for the election of a Member to fill the vacancy in the Legislative Council for the District of *North Esk* until after the First day of *May*, One thousand nine hundred and two.
