

AN ACT to amend "The *East Coast* Harbour and Coal Company's Act." A.D. 1890.  
[2 October, 1890.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to extend certain provisions of "The *East Coast* Harbour and Coal Company's Act" (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act:")

PREAMBLE.  
52 Vict. No. 47.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The *East Coast* Harbour and Coal Company's Amendment Act." Short title.

2 Where before the passing of this Act any enactment contained in the said Act shall be deemed to have expired, such enactment is hereby revived; and whenever in the said Act any number or term of years or months are to be computed as from the passing of the said Act, such number or term of years or months shall hereafter be computed as from the date of the passing of this Act. Certain provisions of 52 Vict. No. 47 revived and extended.

3 This Act and the said Act shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.
