AN ACT to authorise the raising of Money for A.D. 1873. the Erection of Lines of Electric Telegraph. [31 October, 1873.]

W HEREAS it is expedient to raise, by Loans secured on the PREAMBLE. Consolidated Revenue Fund, moneys for the erection of certain Lines of Electric Telegraph :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :-

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor to cause to be raised by the Power to raise issue and sale of Debentures secured on the Consolidated Revenue £7500 for Electric Fund, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act 20th Victoria, No. 9, Debentures such sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole £7500, as secured on Con-may be required for the purpose of defraying the cost of erecting and solidated Revenue completing the Lines of Electric Telegraph authorised to be erected and Fund. completed by "The Electric Telegraphs Act, 1873;" and such Debentures shall be redeemable in the year 1878.

2 All the provisions contained in the said Act of the 20th Victoria, Provisions of No. 9, shall apply and extend to the Debentures to be issued in 20 Vict. No. 9, to apply to such pursuance of this Act.

3 This Act may be cited as "The Electric Telegraphs Loans Act, Short Title. 1873."
