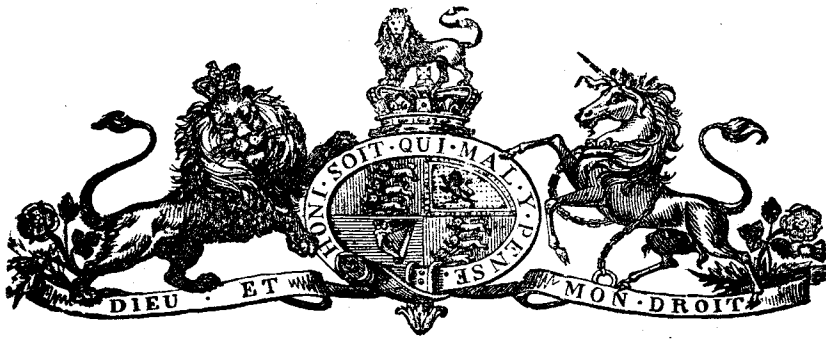

AN ACT to authorise the raising of Money for A.D. 1873.
the Erection of Lines of Electric Telegraph.
[31 October, 1873.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to raise, by Loans secured on the PREAMBLE.
Consolidated Revenue Fund, moneys for the erection of certain Lines of
Electric Telegraph :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor to cause to be raised by the Power to raise
issue and sale of Debentures secured on the Consolidated Revenue £7500 for Electric
Fund, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act 20th *Victoria*, No. 9, Telegraphs by
such sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole £7500, as Debentures
may be required for the purpose of defraying the cost of erecting and secured on Con-
completing the Lines of Electric Telegraph authorised to be erected and solidated Revenue
completed by "The Electric Telegraphs Act, 1873;" and such Deben- Fund.
tures shall be redeemable in the year 1878.

2 All the provisions contained in the said Act of the 20th *Victoria*, Provisions of
No. 9, shall apply and extend to the Debentures to be issued in 20 Vict. No. 9,
pursuance of this Act. to apply to such
Debentures.

3 This Act may be cited as "The Electric Telegraphs Loans Act, Short Title.
1873."
