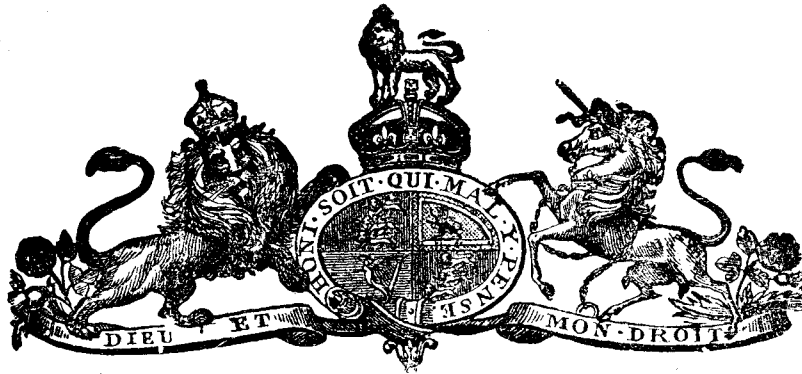

AN ACT to amend the Forestry Act, 1920, and to authorise the Conservator of Forests to refund a proportion of certain Royalties.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “ The Forestry Act, 1929.”

Short title.

2—(1) The Forestry Act, 1920, is hereby amended by repealing Sections 59a and 59b thereof.

(2) The Forestry Act, 1927, is hereby repealed.

Conservator may

3 It shall be lawful for the Conservator to refund to any person who has paid to him any royalty on timber for sawmilling purposes in respect of the period from the first day of July to the thirty-first day of August, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, a sum equal to the amount of the difference between the sum so paid and the amount which would have been payable by such person in respect of the same timber under the scale prescribed by Regulation 97 as amended on the thirtieth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine.
