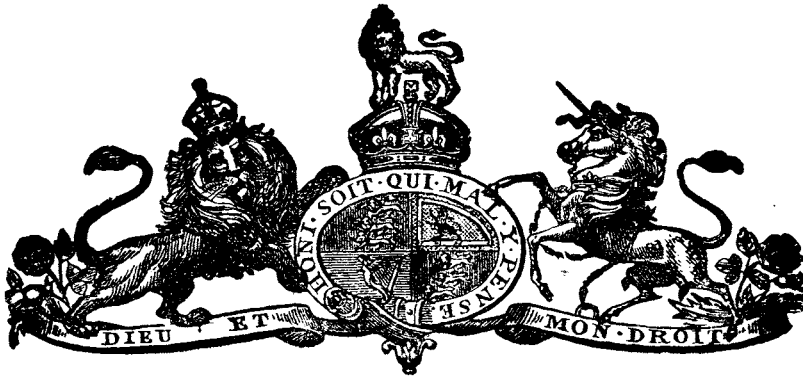

AN ACT to amend the Fisheries Act, 1925.
[24 December, 1929.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Fisheries Act, 1929.”

2 The Fisheries Act, 1925, is hereby amended—

- I. By expunging Subsection (2) of Section Eight thereof :
- II. By adding at the end of Paragraph ii. of Subsection (1) of Section Fourteen thereof the words “and providing for the refund of licence fees” :
- III. By deleting the words “One-half part” in the third line of Section Twenty-one thereof and substituting therefor the words “One quarter.”
- IV. By adding at the end of Section Forty-six thereof the following paragraph :—
 - “iii. To stop and search any vehicle, and at all reasonable times to enter and search any premises, and to search any bags, baskets, or other receptacles, which, in any of the said cases, are suspected, on reasonable grounds, to contain, or to be used for the concealment of, fish taken in contravention of this Part.” :
- V. By inserting after the word “require” in the first line of Paragraph iv., and in the first line of Paragraph v., respectively, of Section Forty-seven thereof the words “the owner, or the person in whose name the fishing-boat is registered, or” :
- VI. By adding at the end of the definition of “Anglers’ Association,” in Section Seventy-one thereof the words “and such other associations as from time to time may be approved by the Commissioners” :
- VII. By inserting after Section Seventy-three thereof the following new Section **73a** :—
 - “**73a** Each of the Commissioners shall be entitled to be paid, out of the funds at the disposal of the Commissioners, all such travelling and other out-of-pocket expenses as are reasonably incurred by him in the performance of his duties as such Commissioner.” :
- VIII. By inserting after Paragraph viii. of Subsection (1) of Section Eighty the following new paragraph :—
 - “viii. Prohibiting the sale of any specified kind or species of fish as defined by this Part :” :
- IX. As to Subsection (1) of Section Eighty-nine thereof—
 - (a) By inserting after the word “fish” in Paragraph i. the words “Penalty : Minimum, Ten Pounds : Maximum, Twenty Pounds” ;
 - (b) By inserting after the word “fish” in the fourth line of Paragraph ii. the words “Penalty : Twenty Pounds” ;
 - (c) By inserting after the word “thereof” in the fifth line of Paragraph iii. the words “Penalty : Twenty Pounds” ;

- (d) By inserting after the word "fish" in the third line of Paragraph iv. the words "Penalty: Twenty Pounds"; A.D. 1929
- (e) By deleting the words "Penalty: Twenty Pounds" in the fifteenth line; and
- (f) By inserting after Paragraph iv. the following paragraph:—
 "v. Use any explosive substance for the purpose of taking or killing fish.
 Penalty: Minimum, Fifteen Pounds :
 Maximum, Twenty Pounds."

X. By adding at the end of Section One hundred and seven thereof the following paragraph:—

"III. To stop and search any vehicle, and at all reasonable times to enter and search any premises, and to search any bags, baskets, or other receptacles, which, in any of the said cases, are suspected, on reasonable grounds to contain, or to be used for the concealment of, fish taken in contravention of this Part."

3 It shall be lawful for the Governor, by order-in-council, to extend the term of office of the Salmon and Freshwater Fisheries Commissioners who were appointed as from the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, or such period, not exceeding three months, as the Governor may think fit, and such Commissioners thereupon shall hold office for such extended term accordingly.
