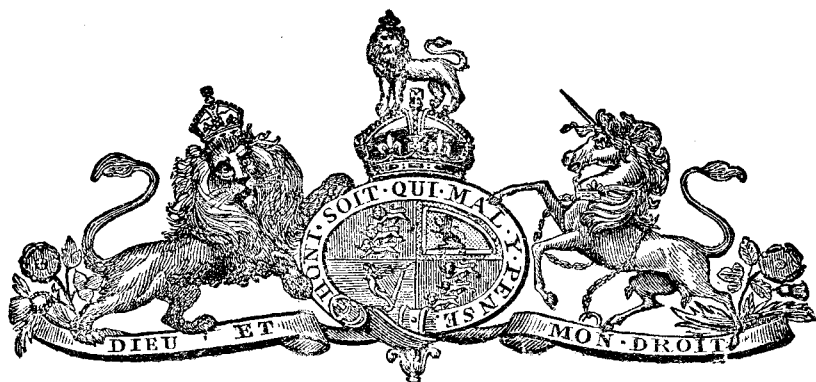

AN ACT to amend the Fisheries Act, 1925.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Fisheries Act, 1930.”

2 The Fisheries Act, 1925, is hereby amended—

I. By deleting the word “Fifteen” in the second line of Subsection (1) of Section Seventy-two, and substituting therefor the word “Sixteen”; and

II. By expunging Paragraph *viii.* of Subsection (1) of Section Eighty (inserted by the Fisheries Act, 1929), and substituting therefor the following new Paragraph *viii.* :—

“*viii.* Prohibiting the sale, or exposure for sale, or the possession by any specified classes of persons on business premises, of any specified kind or species of fish:”.
