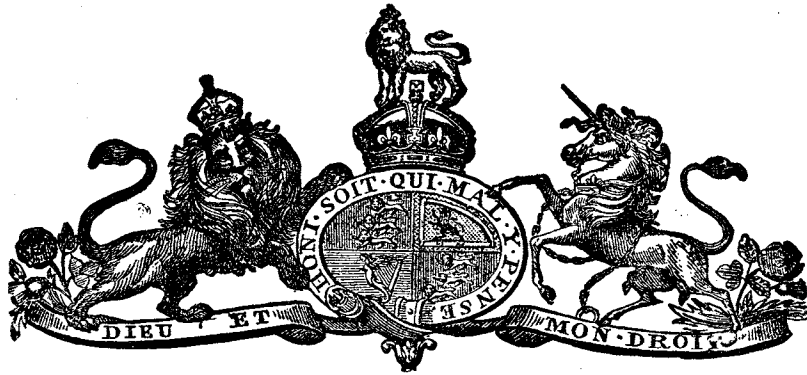

AN ACT to amend "The Foreign Companies
Amendment Act, 1905." A.D.
1911
[21 December, 1911.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Foreign Companies Amendment Act, 1911," and shall be incorporated and read as one with "The Foreign Companies Amendment Act, 1905," in this Act referred to as the said Act. Short title and
