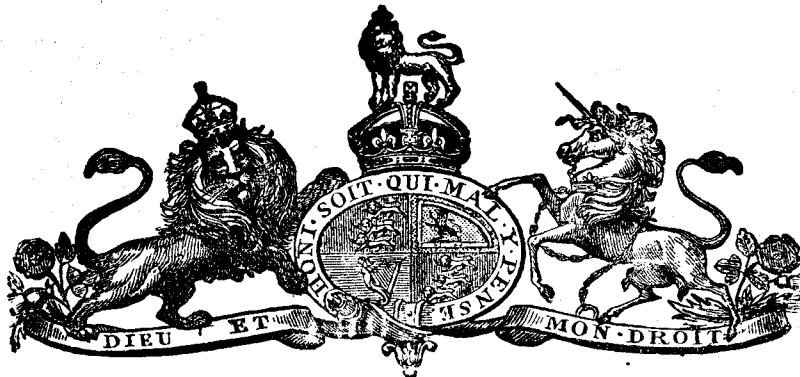

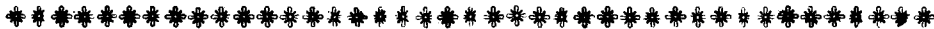

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The *Frogmore* Estate Purchase ^{Short title and} Facilitation Act, 1909." ^{incorporation.}

Frogmore Estate Purchase.

Portion of Frogmore Estate under offer may be purchased for purposes of "The Closer Settlement Act, 1906," notwithstanding certain annuity charged thereon, if Minister satisfied as to indemnity.

2 For the purposes of closer settlement under "The Closer Settlement Act, 1906," the Minister of Lands and Works may, on the recommendation of the Board, in the manner provided by that Act, purchase by agreement and acquire for the Crown the portion of the *Frogmore* Estate now under offer to His Majesty notwithstanding the same is charged with a certain annuity of Fifty Pounds: Provided the Minister is satisfied that His Majesty is protected or indemnified against all claims in respect of the said annuity.
