

AN ACT to validate the Election of Trustees of the Road District of *Flinders Island* held on the Thirtieth day of *June*, One thousand nine hundred and six, and for other purposes. [30 *November*, 1906.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The *Flinders Island* Road Trust Validation Act, 1906.” Short title.

2 No acts or proceedings of the *Flinders Island* Road Trust, or of any person acting as Chairman or Member of the said Trust, shall be invalidated by reason of any defect in the appointment or election, or of any disqualification, of any such person, or by reason of there being any vacancy in the number of members of the said Trust at the time

of such acts or proceedings, nor shall any advantage be taken of any such invalidity in any action or suit which is brought by or against the said Trust.

Elections declared valid.

3 It is hereby declared that the persons who were on the Thirtieth day of *June*, One thousand nine hundred and six, declared duly elected as Trustees of the Road District of *Flanders Island* at a meeting of landholders then held for the election of such Trustees, were duly elected, and that the election so held on the said date was and is valid for all purposes.
