

## \*\*\*\*\*

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1-(1) This Act may be cited as "The Fisheries Regulations Short title. Validation Act, 1924."

(2) "The Fisheries Act, 1889," is herein called "the Principal Act." Principal Act.

2—(1) The several articles or regulations contained in the Govern-Validation of ment notices referred to, and identified in the schedule hereto, shall for regulations. all purposes and in all respects be deemed to have been from the respective dates of publication in the "Gazette" of the Government notices in which the same are respectively contained, valid regulations regularly and lawfully made, approved, and otherwise perfected pursuant Fisheries Regulations Validation.

A.D. 1924. to and in conformity with the Principal Act and every other statute in that behalf, and to have respectively taken effect and acquired the force of law according to the tenor thereof as valid regulations pursuant to and in confirmity with the Principal Act from the respective dates of the publication of the said notices in the "Gazette." as set forth in the schedule.

Application of section.

(2) This section shall not affect—

- 1. The validity or operation of any judgment, decision, determination, or order pronounced or made, before the commencement of this Act, by any court, judge, or justice, and which was based on the invalidity or supposed invalidity of any of the said regulations : or
- II. Any proceedings pending at the time of the commencement of this Act for a breach of any of the said regulations.

Amendment of Section 4 of the Principal Act. **3** Section Four of the Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting the following Subsection (3) after Subsection (2) thereof :—

"(3) Seven Commissioners shall form a quorum for the transaction of business."
