

AN ACT to further amend "The Formby 1 Water Act, 1889," and to authorise a further Loan of Two thousand Pounds to the Council of the Municipality of Devonport.

[30 November, 1909.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to further amend "The Formby Water PREAMBLE. Act, 1889:"

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Formby Water Short title, Amendment Act, 1909."

Formby Water Amendment.

A.D. 1909.

Interpretation.

2 In this Act—

"Council" means the Warden, Councillors, and electors of the Municipality of *Devonport*:

"The said Act" means "The Formby Water Act, 1889."

Power to borrow £2000 in addition to £20,000 (55 Vict. No. 69), £5000 (2 Ed. VII. No. 25), and £4000 (7 Ed. VII. No. 11).

Loan of £2000 may be granted to the Council without taking poll.

- 3 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the said Act or any amendment thereof, it shall be lawful for the Council to borrow the sum of Two thousand Pounds, in addition to the sums of Twenty thousand Pounds, Five thousand Pounds, and Four thousand Pounds already borrowed, for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the said Act and its amendments.
- 4 It shall be lawful for the Governor to grant, in accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," and without any further poll being had, the sum of Two thousand Pounds as an additional loan to the Council for the purpose of defraying the cost of completing the scheme of works for which the loan of Four thousand Pounds was authorised by "The Formby Water Amendment Act, 1907;" and such sum of money shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for the purpose. The proviso to Section Two of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," shall not apply to such loan. Provided that no part of such loan shall be paid to the Council until the Engineer-in-Chief shall have certified that he is satisfied with the manner in which the Council proposes to expend or has expended the same.

Citation of Formby Water Acts 5 The said Act and every Act amending the same and this Act may be referred to and may be cited for all purposes as "The Formby Water Acts, 1889 and 1909."
