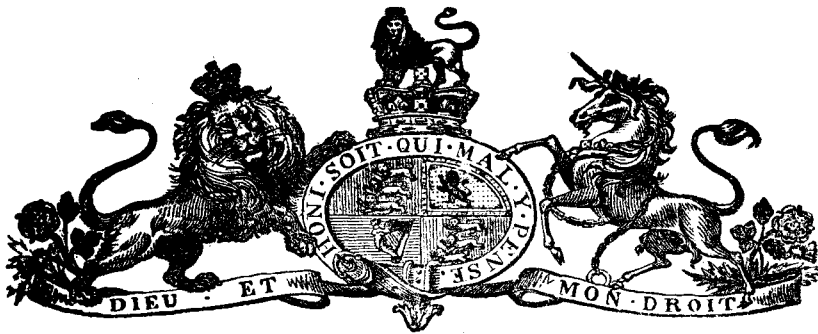

AN ACT to amend "The Game Protection Act, 1879." [29 October, 1883.] A.D. 1883.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Game Protection Act, 1879 :"  
**PREAMBLE.**  
42 Vict. No. 24.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** So much of Section Nine of "The Game Protection Act, 1879," as prescribes the breeding season for Wattle Birds and Quail, is hereby repealed. **Repeal.**

**2** The breeding season for Wattle Birds shall be from the 1st day of *August* in every year to the Twenty-third day of *May* in every succeeding year, both days inclusive. The breeding season for Quail shall be from the Thirty-first day of *July* in every year to the Thirtieth day of *April* in every succeeding year, both days inclusive. **Breeding season for Wattle Birds and Quail.**

**3** The said Act and this Act shall be read and construed together as one Act. **Acts to be read together.**

**4** This Act may be cited as "The Game Protection Amendment Act, 1883." **Short title.**
