

AN ACT to amend "The Game Protection A.D. 1887. Act. 1879." $[20 \ December, 1887.]$

W HEREAS it is expedient to further amend "The Game Protection PREAMBLE. 42 Vict. No. 24.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 In this Act—

Interpretation.

- "The said Act" means "The Game Protection Act, 1879":
- "Quail" means the bird called Quail in the said Act, and also the bird usually called the Californian Quail.
- 2 Every person who, within the period of One year from the com- Penalty for mencement of this Act, commits any of the following offences shall for killing Quail and every such offence forfeit and pay a penalty not exceeding Twenty Wattle Birds. Shillings:

Shoots at or wilfully kills or captures or has in his possession or control any Quail, or destroys or offers for sale the eggs of any

Shoots at or wilfully kills or captures or has in his possession or control any Wattle Bird, or destroys or offers for sale the eggs of any Wattle Bird:

and any person who commits any such offence within the period aforesaid may be proceeded against for the same although such period may have expired.

Penalty for killing, &c. other birds.

- 3 Every person who commits any of the following offences shall forfeit and pay a penalty not exceeding Twenty Shillings:—
 - 1. Shoots at or wilfully kills or captures any Shrike Thrush (Colluricincla Selbyi), or destroys the eggs of any Shrike Thrush (Colluricincla Selbyi):
 - 2. Shoots at or wilfully kills or captures any Pink-breasted Robin (*Erythrodryas rhodinogaster*), or destroys the eggs of any Pink-breasted Robin (*Erythrodryas rhodinogaster*):
 - 3. Shoots at or wilfully kills or captures any Scarlet-breasted Robin (Petroica multicolor), or destroys the eggs of any Scarlet-breasted Robin (Petroica multicolor):
 - 4. Shoots at or wilfully kills or captures any Flame-breasted Robin (Petroica phænicea), or destroys the eggs of any Flame breasted Robin (Petroica phænicea):

- **47.** Shoots at or wilfully kills or captures any Spotted Diamond Bird (*Pardalotus punctatus*), or destroys the eggs of any Spotted Diamond Bird (*Pardalotus punctatus*):
- 48. Shoots at or wilfully kills or captures any Forty-spot Diamond Bird (*Purdalotus quadragintus*), or destroys the eggs of any Forty-spot Diamond Bird (*Pardalotus quadragintus*):
- 49. Shoots at or wilfully kills or captures any Allied Diamond Bird (Pardalotus affinis), or destroys the eggs of any Allied Diamond Bird (Pardalotus affinis):
- 50. Shoots at or wilfully kills or captures any Sky Lark (Alauda arvensis), or destroys the eggs of any Sky Lark (Alauda arvensis):

- 51. Shoots at or wilfully kills or captures any Starling (Sturnus A.D. 1887. vulgaris), or destroys the eggs of any Starling (Sturnus vulgaris).
- 4 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this Act Governor may or the said Act, or any amendment thereof, the Governor may, in writing, authorise any person at any time to kill, capture, or destroy any native game or imported game, or any birds or the eggs thereof, or any animal or the progeny thereof which is protected by this Act or the said Act, or any amendment thereof, or by any Proclamation issued thereunder provided that the Cureton of the Tagger Museum shell thereunder, provided that the Curator of the *Tasmanian* Museum shall be satisfied that any such person requires any such native game, imported game, bird or the eggs thereof, or any such animal or the progeny thereof, for a scientific purpose.

- 5 The said Act, as amended by this Act, and this Act, shall be read Acts to be read and construed together as one Act. together.
- 6 This Act may be cited as "The Game Protection Amendment Short title. Act, 1887."
