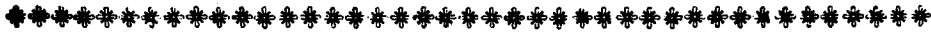

AN ACT to further amend "The Game Protection Act, 1879." [9 November, 1889.] A.D. 1889.

WHEREAS it is expedient that "The Game Protection Act, 1879," should be amended in certain particulars: PREAMBLE. 42 Vict. No. 24.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The word "January," in the Fourth line of Section Fifteen of "The Game Protection Act, 1879," is hereby expunged, and the word "March" is hereby inserted in lieu thereof; and the said Section shall hereafter be read as if the word "March" had always been inserted therein. Amendment of Sect. 15 of 42 Vict. No. 24.

"The close season" for Kangaroo shall, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the said Section, be the interval between the First day of August and the Thirtieth day of March in the succeeding year, both days inclusive.

2 Every person who, within the period of One year from the commencement of this Act, shoots at or wilfully kills or captures, or has in his possession or control, any Black Swan (Cygnus atratus) or Cygnet, or destroys or offers for sale the eggs of any Black Swan (Cygnus atratus) or Cygnet, shall, for every such offence, forfeit and pay a penalty not exceeding Twenty Shillings. Penalty for killing certain birds.

3 This Act and "The Game Protection Act, 1879," and every Act amending the same shall, save as amended by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.

4 This Act may be cited as "The Game Protection Amendment Act, 1889." Short title.
