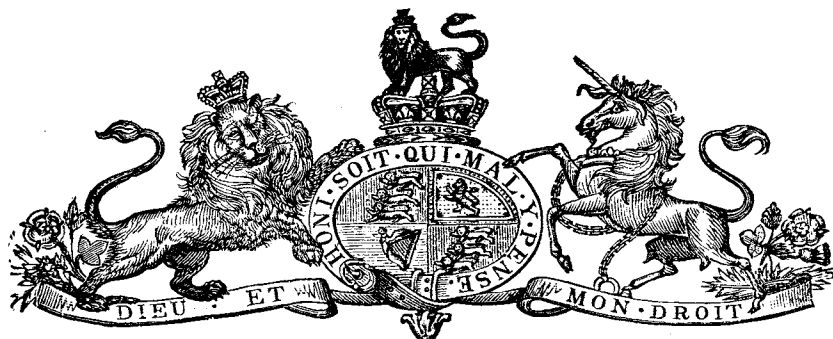

AN ACT to amend "The Game Protection Act, 1895." A.D. 1896.
[2 October, 1896.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Game Protection Amendment Act, 1896." Short title.

2 In this Act, the expression "the said Act" shall mean "The Game Protection Act, 1895." Interpretation. 59 Vict. No. 26.

3 The term "Imported Game" as used in the said Act shall be deemed to mean and include Wonga Wonga Pigeon (*Leucosarcia picata*). Wonga Wonga Pigeon protected.

4 Section Eight of the said Act is hereby repealed, and the following Section shall be and be deemed to be and may be cited as Section Eight of the said Act :— Breeding seasons of Native Game.

"**8** The following shall be deemed to be the breeding seasons for Native Game; that is to say,—

For Wild Ducks, Teal, Widgeon, Plover, Black Swans, Southern Stone Plover, Ground Doves, and Cape Barren Geese, from the

Game Protection.

A.D. 1896.

First day of *July* in every year to the last day of *January* in every succeeding year, both days inclusive :

For Bronze-winged Pigeons from the First day of *August* in every year to the last day of *February* in every succeeding year, both days inclusive :

For Wattle Birds from the First day of *August* in every year to the Twenty-third day of *May* in every succeeding year, both days inclusive :

For Quail from the First day of *July* in every year to the Thirtieth day of *April* in every succeeding year, both days inclusive."

Acts to be read together.

5 This Act and the said Act, save as amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act
