

AN ACT to authorise the Council of the 1933. Municipality of Glenorchy to borrow the Sum of Two Thousand Pounds, under the provisions of the Local Bodies Loans Act,

1881, and for other purposes.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Glenorchy Private Streets Loan Short title. Act, 1933."

Glenorchy Private Streets Loan.

2 In this Act—

Interpretation.

- "The Corporation" means the Warden, councillors, and electors of the Municipality of Glenorchy:
- "The Council" means the Council of the Corporation.

Power to borrow, 45 Vict, No. 16.

3 It shall be lawful for the Council, on behalf of the Corporation, to borrow, under the provisions of the Local Bodies Loans Act, 1881, any sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole the sum of Two thousand Pounds, for the purpose of constructing certain private streets within the towns proclaimed as such under the provisions of the Town Boards Act, 1896, and its amendments, in the said Municipality, and defraying the expenses of the preparation and passing of this Act.

Sinking fund.

4 The amount payable by the Council as an annual contribution towards a sinking fund in respect of any moneys borrowed under this Act shall be a sum equal to Three Pounds per centum of the moneys so borrowed.

Exclusion of of 45 Vict. No. 16.

5 The provisions of Sections Fifteen and Sixteen of the Local certain provisions Bodies Loans Act shall not apply to any moneys to be raised under this Act.
