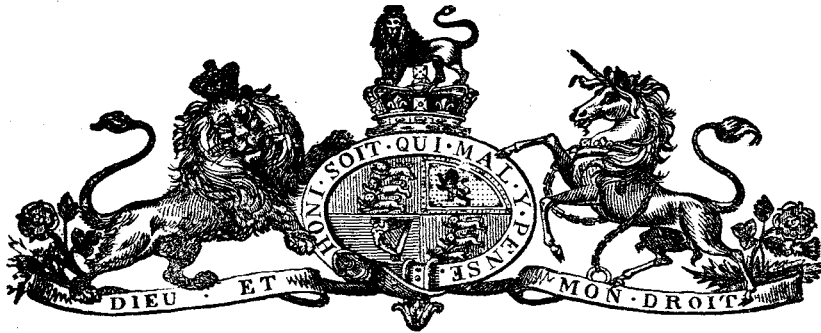

AN ACT to make provision in respect of the <sup>A.D. 1883.</sup>  
Salary and Allowances of His Excellency the  
Governor of *Tasmania*.

[Reserved, 29 October, 1883; Royal Assent proclaimed, 21 January, 1884.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** The Acts mentioned in the Schedule (1) shall be and are hereby **Repeal.**  
repealed, save as to all things duly done thereunder.

**2** There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of this Colony, for and in respect of the Salary and Allowances of every Governor of this Colony, the sums set forth in the Schedule (2). And such sums shall include all provision for the Travelling Expenses of the Governor, Fuel and Light for Government House, Stationery and Stores, and all other expenses, except the cost of the Furniture and Repairs hereinafter mentioned. **Sums payable annually for Governor's Salary, &c.**

**3** The Government House, together with its stables, outbuildings, fences, and other appurtenances, shall be kept in substantial repair, and the whole of the rooms in the said House shall be kept and furnished throughout, and the cost thereof shall be defrayed out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund. **Government House to be kept in repair, and furnished out of Consolidated Revenue Fund.**

The cost of such Repairs and Furniture shall not exceed in any one year the sum of Six hundred Pounds.

4 This Act shall commence and take effect upon the publication in *The Hobart Gazette* of the Governor's Proclamation signifying that Her Majesty has been pleased to assent to the same.
