

## VICTORIÆ REGINÆ,

AN ACT to make provision for the Salary A.D. 1892. and Allowances of every future Governor of Tasmania.

[Reserved, 25 November, 1892; Royal Assent proclaimed, 27 March, 1893.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :-

- 1 On and after the day on which His Excellency Sir Robert Repeal of George Crookshank Hamilton ceases to hold office as Governor of 47 Vict. No. 48. Tasmania, "The Governor's Salary Act, 1883," shall be and is hereby repealed.
- 2 There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Sums payable this Colony, for and in respect of the Salary and Allowances of every annually for Governor of this Colony, except His Excellency Sir Robert George Salary, &c. Crookshank Hamilton, the sums set forth in the Schedule hereto. And such sums shall include all provision for the Travelling Expenses of the Governor, Fuel and Light for Government House, Stationery and Stores, and all other expenses, except the cost of the Furniture and Repairs hereinafter mentioned.

3 The Government House, together with its stables, outbuildings, Government fences, and other appurtenances, shall be kept in substantial repair, and House to be kept the whole of the rooms in the said House shall be kept and furnished in repair, and

furnished out of Consolidated Revenue Fund. throughout, and the cost thereof shall be defrayed out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

The cost of such Repairs and Furniture shall not exceed in any one year the sum of Six hundred Pounds.

Short title.

4 This Act may be cited as "The Governor's Salary Act, 1892."
