



AN ACT to amend "The *Glenorchy* Water Act, 1890." [23 December, 1891.] A.D. 1891.

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend "The *Glenorchy* Water Act, 1890," in the manner hereinafter appearing: PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The *Glenorchy* Water Act Amendment Act, 1891." Short title.

2 In the construction and for the purposes of this Act, unless the context otherwise determines— Interpretation.

The expression "the said Act" shall mean "The *Glenorchy* Water Act, 1890":

The expression "the said Trustees" shall mean the Trustees for the time being of the *Glenorchy* Water District.

3 Notwithstanding anything in the said Act contained, it shall be lawful for the said Trustees to borrow and take up at interest in the manner directed by the said Act, or in accordance with the provisions of this Act, such sum or sums of money not exceeding £12,000 (Twelve thousand Pounds) in the whole as shall from time to time be necessary for effectuating the objects authorised by the said Act. Trustees may borrow.

4 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, under and subject to the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," to grant to the said Trustees as loans for effectuating the objects of the said Act, any sum or sums of money not exceeding £12,000 (Twelve thousand Pounds) in the whole. Governor in Council may grant loan. 54 Vict. No. 30.

5 This Act and the said Act, save as amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.
