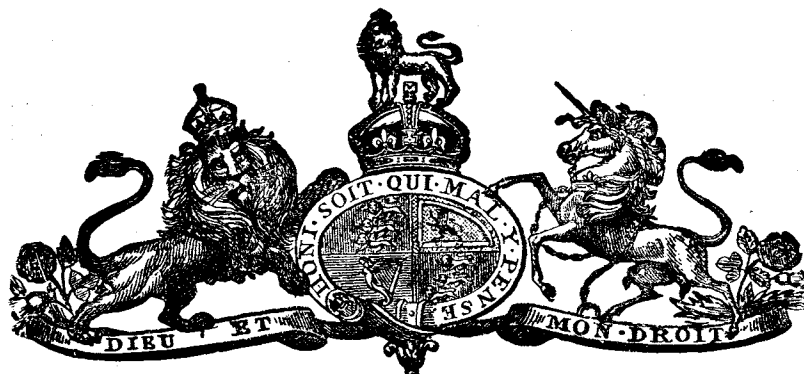

AN ACT to amend "The Homes Act, 1919." ^{A.D.} 1923.
[9 November, 1923.] —

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as "The Homes Act, 1923."
- (2) "The Homes Act, 1919," is herein called the Principal Act.

2—(1) For the purposes of the Principal Act, the Treasurer is hereby empowered to borrow, or raise by way of loan, in Tasmania or elsewhere, in addition to any sum or sums of money which he has already borrowed, or is empowered to borrow, under the Principal Act, any further sum or sums of money which shall not exceed in the whole the sum of Thirty-five thousand Pounds.

(2) All moneys authorised by this Act to be borrowed or raised may be borrowed or raised in the manner provided by Subsection (2) of Section Eight of the Principal Act.

(3) All moneys raised or received under this Act shall be subject to the provisions of the Principal Act in the same manner as if such moneys had been raised or received under the Principal Act.
