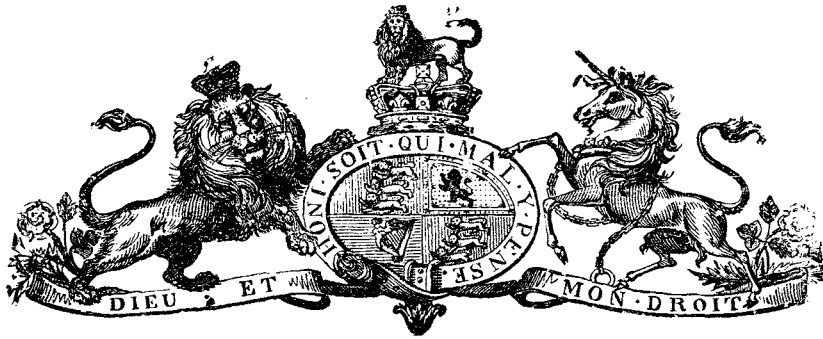

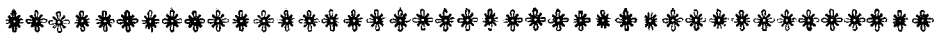

AN ACT to further amend "The *Hobart* Corporation Act, 1893." [12 *October*, 1899.]

A.D. 1899.

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend "The *Hobart* Corporation Act, 1893," in the manner hereinafter appearing: PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The *Hobart* Corporation Act, 1899." Short title.

2 In this Act the expression "the said Act" shall mean "The *Hobart* Corporation Act, 1893," and the word "Council" shall mean "the Municipal Council of the City of *Hobart*." Interpretation. 57 Vict. No. 11.

3 It shall be lawful for the Council from time to time to appropriate out of the revenues of the Corporation such sum or sums as the Council shall think proper for and towards all or any of the following purposes:— Power to expend money on recreation grounds, &c.

For the improvement of any recreation ground, pleasure resort, or public reserve within the City of *Hobart* which may be from time to time vested in the Corporation or under the control of the Council:

Hobart Corporation.

For repairing, levelling, draining, planting, laying out, or improving any such recreation ground, pleasure resort, or public reserve, and providing such amusements on such recreation ground, pleasure resort, or public reserve, as the Council shall deem desirable.

Amendment of
Section 103 of
the said Act.

4 The words "One Shilling and Sixpence" are hereby expunged from the Fourteenth and Fifteenth lines of the One hundred and third Section of the said Act, and the words "One Shilling and Nine Pence" are hereby inserted in lieu thereof.

Acts to be read
together.

5 This Act and the said Act shall be read and construed together as one Act.
