

1. Short title.

2. Power to Treasurer to reappropriate £336,063 5s. 4d. for purposes of Schedule (1).

AN ACT to authorise the Reappropriation of 1933. certain Moneys, and their Application in Defraying the Cost of certain Hydro-Electric [5 January, 1934.] Works.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Hydro-Electric Works Reap- Short title. propriation Act, 1933."

Hydro-Electric Works Reappropriation.

Power to Treasurer to for purposes of Schedule (1). 20 Geo. V. No.

2 The Treasurer may reappropriate the sums specified in Schedule (2), being unexpended balances of the amounts appropriated for the items set forth in that schedule, and apply the aggregate thereof, amounting to the sum of Three hundred and thirty-six thousand and reappropriate amounting to the sum of Three hundred and thirty-six thousand and 2336,063 5s. 4d. sixty-three Pounds Five Shillings and Four Pence, in accordance with the provisions of the Hydro-Electric Commission Act, 1929, in defraying the cost of the execution of the works, and for the purposes specified in Schedule (1). Provided that the moneys hereby reappropriated in respect of Item 2 of Schedule (1) shall not be available for the execution of any of the works specified in that Item unless such work has been commenced before the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six.
