

AN ACT to further amend The Hobart Town Corporation Act. $\lceil 27 \; December, \; 1872. \rceil$

HEREAS it is expedient to further amend The Hobart Town PREAMBLE. 21 Vict. No. 14.

Corporation Act in certain particulars:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 No Alderman who may resign office at any time not more than Aldermen may Thirty days nor less than Twenty days before the annual election day in resign at a certain December, and who has held office for at least One year immediately period of the preceding the date of his resignation, shall be liable to any fine in being liable to a consequence of such resignation, anything contained in the Fifty-fine. second Section of The Hobart Town Corporation Act to the contrary notwithstanding.

- 2 The vacancy created by any such resignation as last aforesaid How vacancy to shall not be deemed or taken to be an extraordinary vacancy, but such be filled up. vacancy shall be filled up at the then subsequent annual election of Aldermen.
- 3 This Act, and the The Hobart Town Corporation Act, and any Acts to be read Act altering or amending the same, shall, save so far as the same or any together. of them may be altered or amended by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act.
- 4 This Act may be cited as "The Hobart Town Corporation Act Short title. Amendment Act, 1872.
