

AN ACT to further amend The Immigration A.D. 1885. [5 December, 1885.] Act, 1855.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Immigration (Appropriation) Act, Short title. 1885."
- 2 Out of moneys provided by Parliament for that purpose, there Appropriation of shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, under the direction £5000 for nominand control of the Chief Secretary, a sum of Five thousand Pounds for the purposes of immigration to Tasmania on the nominated system, gration. under the Rules and Regulations heretofore made by the Board of Immigration.

3 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of the said sum of Five Repayment to thousand Pounds, to repay to the Bangor Slate Quarry Company any Bangor Company. sum of money not exceeding the sum of Two thousand and eighty-eight Pounds, portion of a sum of money deposited by the said Company in the Treasury to defray the cost of the introduction into Tasmania of certain immigrants in the year 1885.

4 The Immigration Act, 1855, and every amendment thereof, and Acts to be read together. this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act.
