

AN ACT to amend the Tamar Improvement Act 1912. [17 December, 1935.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Tamar Improvement Act 1935.

Section 21.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

- I. As to section twenty thereof—
 - (a) By deleting the numeral "I.": and
 - (b) By expunging paragraph II.:
- II. As to section twenty-one thereof by deleting-
 - (a) The words "and the" to "district" in the second and third lines: and
 - (b) "or municipality" in paragraph III.

Amendment of 9 Geo. V. No. 46.

Section 4.

3 The Tamar Improvement Act (No. 4) is hereby amended by deleting from section four thereof the words—

- I. "or the" to "district" in the first and second lines:
 and
- II. "or municipality" wherever occurring.

Adjustment of accruing liabilities. **4**—(1) The foregoing amendments shall have effect as from the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five, and all existing and accruing liabilities for the payment of the Tamar Rate by the ratepayers in the Municipalities of Beaconsfield, St. Leonards, Lilydale, and George Town, under the provisions thereby amended, shall be adjusted up to that date, and enforceable accordingly.

(2) Any person who, otherwise than as a ratepayer of the City of Launceston, has paid Tamar Rate in respect of any period beyond the date aforesaid shall be entitled to a refund of the amount so paid by him, and the same shall be refunded

accordingly.
