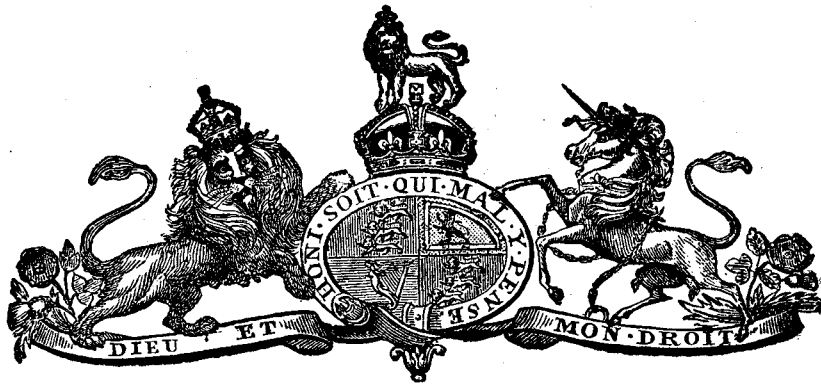

AN ACT to authorise the Loan of Seven thousand Pounds to the Board of the Town of *Invermay*, in accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890." [8 November, 1906.]

WHEREAS the Board of the Town of *Invermay* (being the Local Board of Health thereof) has decided to construct certain sanitary works within the said Town of *Invermay*: PREAMBLE.

And whereas the said Board is desirous of obtaining Legislative authority to borrow the money necessary to carry out the proposed works under the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890:"

And whereas at a Poll of the Electors of the said Town taken on the Twenty-eighth day of *April*, One thousand nine hundred and six, upon the question of whether or not such money should be borrowed for the purposes aforesaid, a majority of over Three-fourths of the votes recorded were in favour of the Board so borrowing:

Invermay Town Board Loan.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Act may for all purposes be cited as “The *Invermay* Town Board Loan Act, 1906.”

The Board may borrow £7000 for sanitary works.

2 It shall be lawful for the Board to borrow any sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole Seven thousand Pounds, for the purpose of defraying the cost of the construction and carrying out of the said works and any expense attending the same.

Governor may grant loan.

3 It shall be lawful for the Governor to grant, under and subject to the provisions of “The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890,” and its Amendments, a sum of Seven thousand Pounds as a Loan to the said Board for the purpose of defraying the cost of the construction and carrying out of the said sanitary works, and any expense attending the same; and such sum of money shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose.

Plans need not be laid before Parliament.

4 It shall not be necessary to lay before either House of Parliament plans and specifications of any proposed works, nor the report of the Engineer-in-Chief thereon, as provided in Section Two of the said Act. But before any part of the said sum is advanced as aforesaid plans and specifications of the proposed works shall be submitted to and approved of by the Governor.

Rate to be levied before payment of Loan by Treasurer.

5 The Board shall, before payment to them by the Treasurer of *Tasmania* of the said Loan, make and levy a Loan Rate under “The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1899,” of an amount sufficient to cover the interest for a year payable by the Board to the State in respect of the Loan as provided by the Act 4 *Edward* VII. No. 23; and such Rate shall not be diminished, and shall, without any further proceeding by the Board or otherwise, be and continue to be an annual recurring Rate upon all ratable property situate within the area of the Town of *Invermay* until full payment of the Loan and all interest payable by the Board to the State in respect thereof.
