



AN ACT to amend the Licensing Act, 1902.  
[8 December, 1926.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as “The Licensing Act, 1926.”

Short title.

**2** The local option poll required by Section Forty-three of the Licensing Act, 1908, to be taken in the City of Hobart on the day immediately preceding the second Friday in December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six, shall be taken on the day preceding the second Friday in the month of May, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, and thereafter shall be taken in every third year on the day preceding the second Friday in the month of May.
