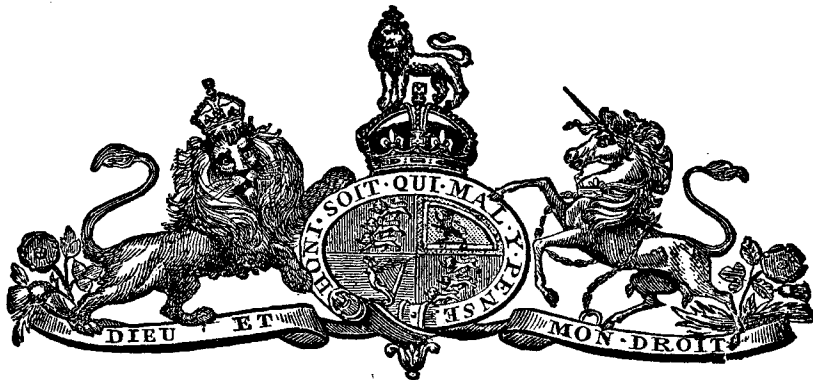

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

2 Section Forty-three of the Licensing Act, 1908, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "twenty" in the seventh line of Subsection (2) thereof the words "Provided that in the district comprised in the City of Hobart such poll as aforesaid shall be taken on the Wednesday preceding the second Friday in May in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two and on the corresponding day in every fourth year thereafter."

3 Section Thirty-eight of the Licensing Act, 1917, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "therefor" in the twelfth line thereof the words "nor to the widow, being not less than thirty years of age, of any deceased licensee or applicant for any of the said licences."
