

AN ACT to amend "The Lotteries Act, A.D. 1891. [17 November, 1891.] 1878."

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Lotteries Act, 1878," PREAMBLE. in manner hereinafter appearing :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

1 This Act may be cited as "The Lotteries Amendment Act, 1891." Short title.

2 In this Act the expression "the said Act" shall mean and include Interpretation. " The Lotteries Act, 1878."

3 The provisions of the said Act shall not apply to any raffle of a Provisions of private nature which is not advertised by public advertisement or 42 Vict. No. 17 any written or printed notice.
