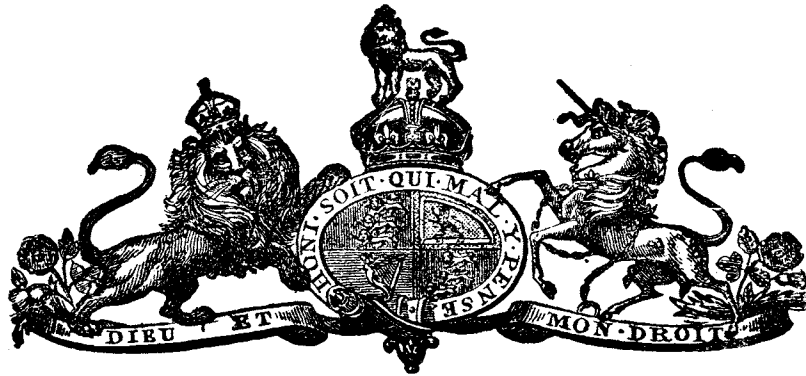

**2** (1)—The expenditure incurred by any local body during the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, out of any moneys at the disposal of such local body, of any sum of money in fitly receiving Their Royal Highnesses the Duke and Duchess of York on the occasion of their recent visit to Tasmania, is hereby declared to have been legal.

(2) For the purposes of this Act “local body” means the municipal council of any city or of any municipality constituted under the Local Government Act, 1906, and any marine board existing under the Marine Act, 1921.
