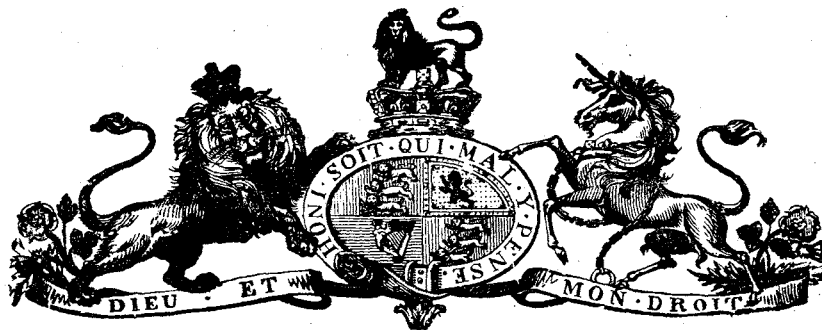

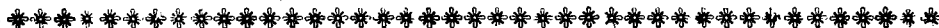

AN ACT to authorise Local Bodies to appropriate Moneys for unforeseen expenditure, and for other purposes. A.D. 1902.

[29 September, 1902.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Local Bodies Unforeseen Expenditure Authorisation Act, 1902.” Short title.

2 In this Act, “Local Body” shall mean and include any Council, Board, Trust, or other public local authority to whom may be delegated under the provisions of any Act now passed or hereafter to be passed the exercise of any public functions reposed in them by such Acts and having the control of any public moneys. Local Bodies Unforeseen Expenditure Authorisation.

A.D. 1902.

Local Bodies may appropriate Three per cent. of revenue for unforeseen expenditure.

3 Any Local Body may, during the year One thousand nine hundred and two or any succeeding year, out of moneys to the credit of such Local Body, expend, for purposes not authorised by any Act for the time being in force, any sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole Three per centum of the total revenue of such Local Body collected during that year, exclusive of any money received by such Local Body by way of Loan, nor exceeding in any one year the sum of Twenty-five Pounds or, in the case of the Municipal Council of the City of *Hobart*, not exceeding in any one year the sum of One hundred Pounds.
