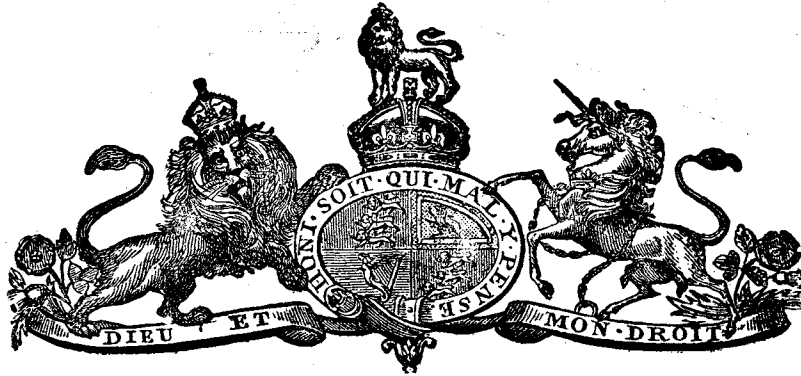

AN ACT to authorise the Marine Board of ^{A.D.} **1907.**
Hobart to erect Lighthouses at or near
Ulverstone and *Stanley* respectively, and for
other purposes. [5 December, 1907.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Lighthouse Construction Act, Short title, 1907."

Lighthouse Construction.

A.D. 1907.

Interpretation.

2 In this Act, the word "lighthouse" includes, in addition to the ordinary meaning of the word, any light or lights exhibited for the guidance of ships.

Marine Board of *Hobart* may construct lighthouses.

3 It shall be lawful for the Marine Board of *Hobart* to construct, erect, and place lighthouses in such manner as the said Board deems fit—

- I. At or near *Ulverstone*, in *Tasmania*: and
- II. On or near the *Nut*, at *Stanley*, in *Tasmania* :
and also to subsequently add to or alter any such lighthouse.

4 The cost of such lighthouses, and of any subsequent addition thereto or alteration thereof, shall be defrayed out of the money to the credit of the fund formed under the provisions of "The Marine Boards Act, 1889," for the maintenance and repair of lighthouses.

Lighthouses to be under control of Marine Board of *Hobart*.

5 The said lighthouses shall be under the management and control of the Marine Board of *Hobart*, who shall maintain and repair the same; and the said lighthouses shall be subject to all the provisions of "The Marine Boards Act, 1889," in the same manner in all respects as other lighthouses now erected in *Tasmania*.
