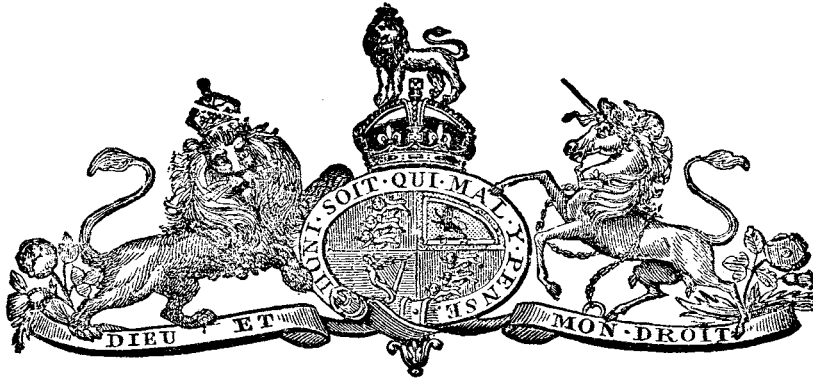

AN ACT to further amend the Launceston Corporation Act, 1894. [9 March, 1926.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend the Launceston Corporation Act, 1894 :

Preamble.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Launceston Corporation Act, 1926." Short title.

Debentures and Instalment Debentures

2 Notwithstanding anything contained in the Launceston Corporation Act, 1894, or any amendment thereof or any other Act—

Dates for payments.

The dates for payment of principal and interest or for payment of instalments of principal and interest payable on any debentures or instalment debentures under Part II. of the Launceston Corporation Act, 1925, may be on other days instead of the Thirty-first day of December or the Thirtieth day of June.

This Section shall apply to all debentures or instalment debentures, whether dated or issued before or after the passing of this Act.

3 Section Thirty of the Launceston Corporation Act, 1925, is hereby repealed.
