

## VICTORIÆ REGINÆ,

No. 28.

AN ACT to amend the Law for the Punishment of Persons making false Declarations at any Election of Aldermen or Auditors under The Launceston Corporation Act.

[17 September, 1868.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 The Twenty-ninth Section of The Launceston Corporation Act, Repeal. and the Fourth Section of The Launceston Corporation Amendment Act, No. 3, are hereby repealed.
- 2 The Burgess's Declaration in the Schedule to The Launceston Burgess's Decla-Corporation Amendment Act, No. 3, is hereby repealed, and the Decla-ration. ration in the Schedule of this Act is substituted in lieu thereof.
- 3 Every person wilfully making the Burgess's Declaration in the Penalty for Schedule in the Act 24th Victoria, No. 22, falsely, and every person false Declaration. wilfully making the Burgess's Declaration in the Schedule of this Act falsely, shall respectively be deemed to be and be guilty of an offence against The Launceston Corporation Act, and shall for each and every such offence be liable to a penalty not exceeding Twenty Pounds; and every person shall be deemed and held to have made either of the said Declarations wilfully upon proof that either of the said Declarations was untrue in fact, unless he proves the contrary.

## Launceston Corporation Amendment Act, No. 4.

Declaration only required of persons voting at Elections. 4 No question shall be permitted to be put to any person applying to vote at any Election of Aldermen or Auditors under *The Launceston Corporation Act* who makes either of the last-mentioned Declarations.

Acts to be read together.

5 This Act, The Launceston Corporation Act, and the Acts 24th Victoria, No. 22, 25th Victoria, No. 12, and The Launceston Corporation Amendment Act, No. 3, and the Act 29th Victoria, No. 30, except in so far as the same are altered or affected by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.

Short Title.

6 This Act may be cited as "The Launceston Corporation Amendment Act, No. 4."

## SCHEDULE.

### BURGESS'S DECLARATION.
