

AN ACT to authorise the raising of Money for the Construction of a Central School at [18 October, 1870.] Launceston.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor to cause to be raised by Power to raise the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the General Revenue, £1200 for Central in like manner as is prescribed by the Act 20th Victoria, No. 9, such Launceston, by sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole £1200, as may be Debentures required towards defraying the cost of constructing and completing secured on the the Central School at Launceston, under "The Launceston Central General Revenue. School Act;" and such Debentures shall be redeemable in the year 1881.

2 All the provisions contained in the said Act of the 20th Victoria, Provisions of No. 9, shall apply and extend to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act.

3 This Act may be cited as "The Launceston Central School Short Title. Act, 1870."
