

AN ACT to further amend "The Launceston A.D. 1893. Electric Light Act, 1887."

[14 November, 1893.]

W HEREAS it is expedient to further amend, in the manner herein- PREAMBLE. after appearing, "The Launceston Electric Light Act, 1887":

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Launceston Electric Light Act, Short title. 1893."
- 2 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines, the expression Interpretation. "the said Act" shall mean "The Launceston Electric Light Act, 1887."
- 3 All works of whatsoever description constructed or commenced All works conbefore the passing of this Act for the purpose of supplying water or structed or light to the City of Launceston or other places under the provisions of commenced by the said Act, shall be deemed to have been constructed or commenced in accordance with the provisions of the said Act; and in any case or light to be in which the said Act required the approval of a majority of the deemed to have Citizens of the City of Launceston for the construction or commencement of any work therein mentioned, and such work has been constructed or commenced before the passing of this Act, such work shall be deemed to have duly received such approval before it was constructed or commenced.
